Quick reference itinerary

Day 1	Morning flight from Arusha airport to Kogatende airstrip in northern Serengeti. Transfer from airstrip to camp. Overnight at Serengeti North Wilderness Camp.	Lunch, dinner
Day 2 /3/4	Days will be spent exploring the Serengeti eco-system in our safari vehicles. We include two game activities daily. Overnight at Serengeti North Wilderness Camp.	Full board including local drinks
Day 5	From Serengeti, fly back to Arusha on a scenic flight over the Rift Valley.	Breakfast

Detailed itinerary

Day 1

Morning flight from Arusha to the Serengeti. A Wild Frontiers representative will meet you at the local airstrip and transfer you by vehicle to your camp.

Serengeti Wilderness Camps are located *inside* the national park, and designed in the safari style of old – simple, but comfortable with every need being taken care of. The camp comprises of maximum 12 tents, each comfortably furnished with great attention to detail. Quality linens, solar lighting, eco-friendly flush toilet and shower en-suite all add to your comfortable stay.



Serengeti North Wilderness camp (open June to November)

This seasonal camp moves from Ndutu (in the south) during the calving season, to the North for the migration and river crossings. Our guides will take you to the best game viewing possible. Sometimes that may entail a long day in the vehicle, other days the game may be close by! Sumptuous meals are prepared by our friendly safari chefs, and are served in the dining tent, or directly under the stars.

Overnight at Serengeti North Wilderness Camp on a full board basis (all meals and local drinks included).

Days 2/3/4

Explore the Serengeti eco-system in our specially customised extended land cruisers, with enlarged windows and heightened roof to allow ease of photography and game-viewing, with plenty of room to stretch your legs. Our land cruisers have game viewing hatches that allow 360 degree views, and are equipped with a cooler box/ fridge and reference books on Tanzania's parks.

The Serengeti National Park is arguably the best known wildlife sanctuary in the world. Serengeti means "endless plains" in the Masai language, and more than 3 million large mammals abound within its borders. About 35 species of plains animals may be seen here, including the so-called "big seven" – buffalo, elephant, lion, leopard, rhino, cheetah and African hunting dog. The black rhino population of the Serengeti has developed in recent years thanks to constant surveillance, but they are restricted to an inaccessible part of the park.

There is, of course, also a profusion of birdlife with over 500 species including bustards, cranes, eagles, herons, owls, storks, vultures and the bizarre, long-legged secretary birds.



But the most popular animals to be found here in greater abundance than elsewhere on the northern circuit are the cats. Lions, cheetahs and leopard may all be seen here along with other predators, such as the spotted hyena, golden and black-backed jackals, wild cats and servals.

Overnight at Serengeti North Wilderness Camp on a full board basis (all meals and local drinks included).

Day 5

Bid farewell to the camp staff, and transfer to the airstrip – allowing a little time for game viewing en route (you never know what you may see!)

Flight back to Arusha

END OF SAFARI

During DECEMBER – MARCH Serengeti North Wilderness Camp moves south with the migration to become Ndutu Wilderness Camp . We don't normally operate fly in safaris here as the camp is a comfortable driving distance from Arusha, but it is possible to fly in should you prefer to do so. It is here that the calving season takes place – a phenomenal time to be in the Serengeti.

Private game drive vehicle: May be organised if booked in advance and subject to availability. Please contact us for a quote.

Tailormade packages: We will happily tailormake any package to meet your requirements.

Charging facilities: There are charging facilities at the lodges/camps as well as on in our Wild Frontiers' safari vehicles for camera batteries, mobile phones etc. Two-pin plugs as well as the round three-square pin plug points.

Weather: Tanzania is a land without winter. Temperatures in northern Tanzania range between 15-21C during the day and 4-10C at night, from May to October. From November to March the daytime temperature varies from 21-32C and from 15-23C at night. However, if you are travelling to high altitude areas like Ngorongoro Crater and Kilimanjaro, of course the temperature drops substantially.

Migration Explained: On the following page please find a Migration guideline that you may find helpful when planning your safari to East Africa. Movement of wildlife depends on a great many aspects – but this is a general overview to the seasonality of game viewing. Remember there is resident game throughout the year in the Serengeti/Ngorongoro eco-systems.

JAN / FEB / MARCH

The big herds of wildebeest are generally in the southern plains of the Serengeti eco-system, calving takes place over approximately two weeks. Lots of predators, good visibility of game, mix of open plains and some woodland.

APRIL / MAY

The herds start moving toward central Serengeti. This is typically the rainy season, however, game viewing is still excellent and there are some great discounts available at lodges and camps. It generally doesn't rain all day. Photography is generally superb with moody skies and good depth of colour.

JUNE / JULY / AUGUST

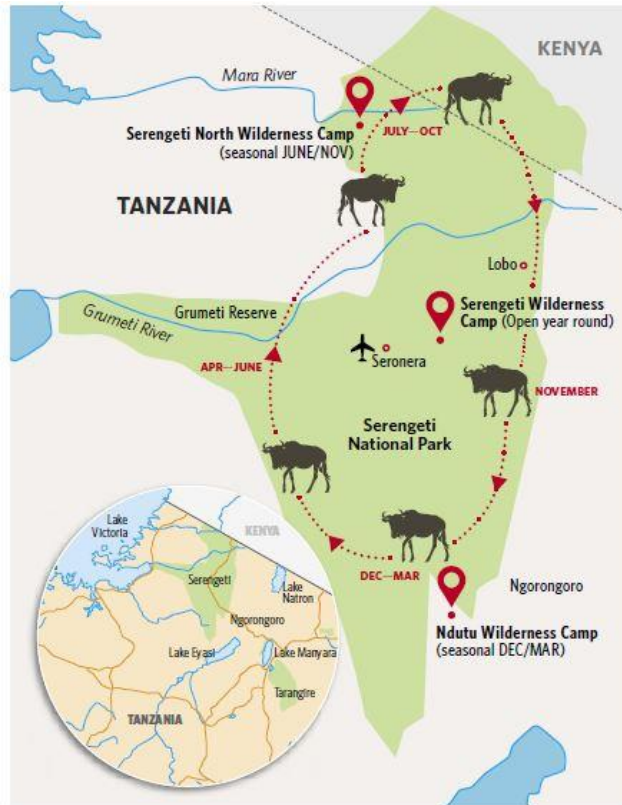
The wildebeest move from the central area and split to the west and north, continuing their trek toward the Mara River. River crossings may be seen in both the western corridor (Grumeti area) and north (Mara River) within the Serengeti.

SEPTEMBER / OCTOBER

Whilst some of the wildebeest successfully reach the Masai Mara, there are still hundreds of thousands remaining in the northern region of Serengeti, offering those with patience the chance to see river crossings (the Mara River runs through the Serengeti).

NOVEMBER / DECEMBER

The big herds start to return from the north, to the southern plains, to start the whole process again!
